## ORDINANCE #82

## WORCESTER TOWNSHIP

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Worcester Township, and it is Ordained and Enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That the Ordinance designated #70, and which pertains to Disorderly Practices, is hereby amended by the addition of the following clauses and/or paragraphs:

- N. To display a house number, or property number, other than the one assigned to the house, or property, by the Township Board of Supervisors.
- 0. To maintain an overflowing, or malfunctioning on-lot sewage disposal system.
- P. The unauthorized taking of water from a public fire hydrant, or with the tampering of an officially installed fire hydrant.

SECTION 2. Any person or person violating this Ordinance or causing or helping others to violate it shall be guilty of the offense of disorderly practices and upon conviction thereof, in a summary proceeding shall be sentenced to pay the costs of prosecution and a fine not exceeding three hundred (\$300) dollars, or in County Jail.
