DECISION

The Applicants/Owners, Robert Cicippio and Debora Cicippio propose to construct an addition to their house at 3070 Mill Road, Worcester Township, in the AGR – Residential Zoning District.

A public hearing on the above Application was held on December 27, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. at the Worcester Township Community Hall, 1031 Valley Forge Road, Fairview Village, Pennsylvania, pursuant to Notice as required by the Worcester Township Zoning Ordinance, as amended (hereinafter "Zoning Ordinance") and the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code. Upon consideration of the evidence and testimony presented regarding the Application, the Zoning Hearing Board of Worcester Township enters the following Order:

ORDER

- (1) A variance from Section 150-13.A(3)(a) of the Zoning Ordinance, so as to permit an addition to the house to encroach into the 50' side yard setback by an additional 4', is GRANTED.
- (2) A variance from Section 162.1 of the Zoning Ordinance, so as to permit the nonconforming structure to encroach 4' further into the side yard, is GRANTED.
 - (3) A determination that the Applicants are entitled to vested right relief is DENIED.

This Decision is subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS:

- The Applicants shall construct the addition to the house in the location as shown on the plan marked as Exhibit A-3, and provide landscaping and install storm water controls as approved by the Township.
- 2. All use and development permitted by this Decision shall conform to the exhibits and testimony presented by the Applicant, unless inconsistent with any specific conditions imposed by this Board, in which case these specific conditions shall take precedence.
- 3. The Applicant shall apply for and obtain all applicable Township, County and State permits and approvals relative to the construction of the addition in a timely manner.
- 4. Except as permitted by prior Decisions of this Board, the use of the subject property shall otherwise comply with the Worcester Township Code, including, but not limited to, all storm water management, fencing, setback, parking, lighting, sign and noise regulations, and all other codes, regulations and ordinances of Worcester Township.
- Pursuant to Section 150-225 of the Worcester Township Zoning Ordinance, a special exception or variance shall expire if the Applicant fails to obtain a permit in connection therewith within one (1) year of the date of authorization thereof. When land development/subdivision approval is required, the special exception or variance shall expire if the Applicant fails to make a diligent effort to obtain such approval within six (6) months following the date of the Zoning Hearing Board's Order. Upon receipt of land development/subdivision approval, the special exception or variance shall expire if a building permit is not obtained within six (6) months of the date of the land development/subdivision approval.
