**No Turnpike traffic restrictions during Memorial Day holiday (May 26, 3 p.m. through June 1, 6 a.m.)
with the exception of emergency roadway repairs**

Allandale Road, Colton Drive, Timberfare Circle, and Loretta Lane Subdivisions - DAY

Plymouth Township

- Walsh Construction will be removing the privacy wall between Township Line Road and Hickory Road southbound May 23-26. Work will occur from 7 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.

Horseshoe Drive & Michaels Lane - DAY

Whitpain Township

- Walsh Construction will be completing excavation operations in the area May 23-26. Work will occur from 7 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.

Jocelyn Road - DAY

Plymouth Township

- Walsh Construction will be completing clearing operations in the area May 23-26. Work will occur from 7 a.m. - 3:30 p.m.

Non-Residential Areas – DAY

Plymouth and Whitpain Townships

- General construction noise may occur this week with no specific areas or neighborhoods affected. Work will occur from 7 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. Residences adjacent to the work area may experience minimal noise impacts from minor excavating, equipment moving, and backup alarms.
- Right-of-way fence* removal will occur in non-residential areas.

**In an effort to remove and replace the right-of-way (ROW) fence prior to leaving the area, the contractor will remove sections of the existing ROW fence (up to 1,000 feet) in order to install new, permanent (5' chain link) ROW fencing the same day. It is important that residents relocate any personal belongings on or near the PTC's ROW fence at your earliest convenience. This will allow our work to proceed in a timely manner and help keep the project on schedule. Thank you.*
