Mr. Cornell,

Please consider this a request under Pennsylvania's new Open Records Law.

1. I would like review any and/or all invoices, cancelled checks, and accounts payable, for any open space and/or farmland preservation, development right purchases in Worcester Township, either executed and/or pending, including the names of the landowners, since 1997 to present.
2. I would like a list of any and/or all open space and/or farmland preservation, development right purchases including name, address, date of purchase, and amount of Township contribution to purchase since 1997. If no such list exists, then I would like to review whatever records completely document each transaction associated with each individual open space and/or farmland preservation development right purchase in Worcester Township since 1997.
3. I would like to review any and/or all records that would document any and/or all financial transactions between Worcester Township and any representatives, including but not limited to consultants, attorneys, and/or engineers of any and/or all of the landowners, individuals, and/or corporations ect. who's development rights were purchased by Montgomery County and/or Worcester Township since 1997
4. I would like to review any and/or all correspondence, including faxes, emails, noted, memo's, ect, between the Worcester Board of Supervisors either collectively and/or individually, the Township Manager and/or acting Township Manager, and/or Worcester Township Open Space Co-ordinator and any and/or all of the parties involved in the purchase of development rights including but not limited to the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners, Montgomery County Planning Commission, Montgomery County Land Trust, and/or any other Department in the County, and/or any and/or all attorneys, consultants and/or engineers .
5. I would like a copy of any and/or all lists and/or record kept by Worcester Township pertaining to Open Space development rights purchases, Development Right Purchases, and also ASA.
6. Any and/or all documentation that would indicate who the Open Space Co-ordinators were in Worcester Township since 1990, including dates of service, and any and/or all documentation pertaining to that position including but not limited to applications and/or letters of resignation.
7. Any and/or all documentation regarding formation, maintenance, and dissolution of an Open Space Committee in Worcester Township including when the Committee was formed and/or terminated, who was on the Committee and their positions, By-Laws of the Committee, Officers of the Committee, and/or minutes from the Open Space Committee since 1990.
7. Any and/or all documentation including minutes, notes, memos, faxes, and emails that pertain to the Open Space Committee and/or the Open Space Co-Ordinator in Worcester Township including but not limited to the Supervisors collectively and/or individually regardless as to whether they were transmitted on

there personal computers and personal email accounts - they are under the control of the Supervisors. Please provide this information beginning in 1990 to present.

If any of this information is available in electronic media, this would be preferable.
