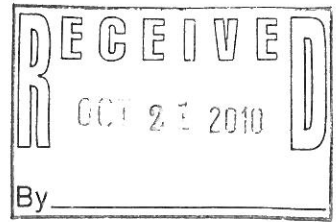

Dave,

Consider this a RTK request.

I would like;

1. Any and/or all Right to Know requests filed by Jeannie R. *Steigerwalt* with the Township concerning the "TARRA" Landscaping business/project for the past 10 years.

2. Mr. Bustard stated that he,

"Had been going back over the records on that as well and spending a little more time looking into the problems in this area since 2006." "Looking at the different issues that have gone to Court on that finding difficulty in getting the applicant to get the applicant to do the things he was ordered to by the court . Rather than have somebody end up putting in asphalt in that they're going to have to tear up later I'd like to ah, I'd like to revisit our decision on that, not to send the Solicitor." The applicant obviously is not going to put down asphalt until his project is approved and whether this applicant puts down "asphalt" should have no bearing on whether the Township waste thousands of dollars on sending the Solicitor to the Zoning Hearing Board.

Mr. Bustard went on to refer to the problems in 2007 and 2008 with "the dumping that he had, and the fact that he cut down all the trees without a permit and as a result has a massive amount of water coming off their into the stream area and eroding the area. I'm just looking at it and saying this is not what should be happening in that situation. **The guy's been pushing us for a while**. He had six months to repair it back in 2007 and didn't do it, we had to go to court on that, we finally got it taken care of. Looks like Lower Providence went to Court to it. He filed application for a storm water plan, he didn't have a Township comprehensive plan and the County didn't have a comprehensive plan. There's a lot of things here that just don't add up." The whole time Mr. Bustard had records that he was reviewing and referring to in front of him. Whether this applicant had a prior violation has no bearing on meeting his current requirements for zoning and to send the Solicitor to oppose this applicant is exposing the Township to potential liability. When asked to explain his "FLIP-FLOP" and who gave him the documents, Bustard had no answer, so,

I would like to review the records, in their entirety, referred to by Chairman Bustard during the Worcester Board of Supervisor's Meeting on 10/20/10, referenced above, during the discussion of the Tarra landscaping project sending the Solicitor to the Zoning Hearing Board.

3. A copy of the audio recording from the Board of Supervisors meeting of 10/20/10.
4. Any and/or all emails to and/or from the Board of Supervisors collectively and/or individually regarding the "Tarra" project, application and/or situation for the last 3 years. I would like these regardless as to whether they are transmitted on private, personal emails accounts and/or computers.

5. Any and/or all emails to and/or from the Township Manager regarding the "Tarra" project, application and/or situation for the last 3 years. I would like these regardless as to whether they are transmitted on private, personal emails accounts and/or computers.
6. Any and/or all emails to and/or from the Tiffany Loomis regarding the "Tarra" project, application and/or situation for the last 1 year. I would like these regardless as to whether they are transmitted on private, personal emails accounts and/or computers.
7. Any and/or all emails to and/or from the Township staff regarding the "Tarra" project, application and/or situation for the last 3 years. I would like these regardless as to whether they are transmitted on private, personal emails accounts and/or computers.

Dave, since the Zoning meeting is 10/26/10, I would appreciate a response and the information prior to the Zoning meeting so that I can make proper comment. In addition, if the information is available in electronic format, this would be preferable and most economical.
