

Notice to the Customers of

NORTH PENN WATER AUTHORITY

Annual inspection and flushing of fire hydrants increase public safety by insuring that hydrants will function when necessary. Flushing of hydrants also improves water quality. The Authority will be flushing and inspecting hydrants in the distribution system during the next seven weeks according to the following tentative schedule (schedule may change due to weather or other related conditions):

APRIL 11 through APRIL 27

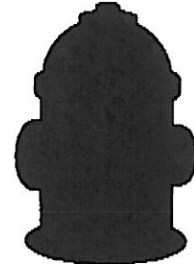

The majority of the flushing will be done at night between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 4:00 a.m. As a result of this procedure, some customers may notice a minor discoloration in the water and/or lower than normal water pressure.

If discoloration occurs, run the cold water for a few minutes. If the water does not clear up, turn off the water for 10 to 20 minutes and try the procedure again. If a problem persists, customers should contact the Authority office at (215) 855-3617, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m.
