Stump Hall Road Bridge to Close Monday in Skippack Township, Montgomery County for Bridge Rehabilitation

KING OF PRUSSIA

Stump Hall Road in Skippack Township, Montgomery County will be closed and detoured starting Monday (November 15) through March 15, 2011 between Anders Road and Route 73 for rehabilitation of the bridge over Zacharias Creek, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation (PennDOT) today announced.

During construction to rehabilitate the structurally deficient bridge, Stump Hall Road through traffic will be detoured over Route 73 and Route 363. Local access will be maintained on Stump Hall Road up to the construction area.

Under this project, an existing 1958 box beam bridge will be improved with structural repairs, new guiderail, pavement markings and signs. The bridge carries about 3100 vehicles per day.

The work is weather dependent.

The general contractor on the \$965,000 project is Loftus Construction of Cinnaminson, NJ. The bridge improvement project is financed with 100 percent state funds.

The contract also includes rehabilitation of two other structurally deficient box beam bridges in 2011: Brinton Lake Road over Chester Creek in Thornbury Township, Delaware County; and New Hanover Square Road over Minister Creek in New Hanover Township, Montgomery County.
