The Worcester Township Open Space Preservation Program seeks to permanently preserve 300 acres of land throughout our community by 2033, our Township's 300th anniversary. This will increase the land preserved to 20% of the Township's total land area.





3335 Fisher Road is located at the intersection of Fisher Road and Hollis Road, a short walk from Fisher's Park and the Milestone community.





The 40-acre property includes a farmhouse and a bank barn, and some of the most beautiful fields, wooded areas, and creekways in Worcester Township.

OPEN SPACE PRESERVATION PROGRAM GOALS

- 1. Permanently preserve lands through purchase or by a conservation easement that forever restricts development.
- 2. Provide public access at all privately-owned lands preserved by a conservation easement.
- Create open spaces that link to neighborhoods, commercial centers, and other open spaces.
- 4. Protect environmentally sensitive lands, including wetlands and animal habitats.
- 5. Establish a Township-wide off-road trail network.
- 6. Keep Worcester Township a great place to live, work, and raise a family!



HOW TO GET INVOLVED

Have land to sell? Contact the Township, and let's talk options... including the Township purchasing the entire property, a portion of the property, or a conservation easement. We'll work to create a plan that works best for you and your family.

Want to donate? Worcester Township has created a special fund that will be only be used to preserve land. The Township will match every contribution made to this fund, up to \$300,000 per year. It's a great way to join in our efforts to protect the higher quality of life Worcester families deserve.
