**CALL TO ORDER**

- **ANNOUNCEMENTS:**  
**The meeting was called to order at 7:07**

The Township Manager announced the meeting would be recorder for future broadcast, and that the Board of Supervisors met in executive session on:

- 1/24/2023 to discuss litigation.
- 2/1/2024 to discuss personnel.
- 2/19/2024 to discuss personnel, litigation, and real estate.

**PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE**

**ATTENDANCE**

All members of the Board of Supervisors were present.

**INFORMATIONAL ITEMS**

The Township manager announced he recently attended a public meeting held by Skippack EMS Service. The meeting discussed financial constraints faced by Skippack EMS.

**OFFICIAL ACTION ITEMS**

Supervisor DeLello made a motion to amend the agenda one to reduce the DJ Pinciotti construction company to \$65,207.70. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Betz. Passed unanimously.

Supervisor DeLello made a motion to move the waver of land development that was under public hearing to Other Business. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Betz. Passed unanimously.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

Christopher DePaul Whitehall Farms 1616 Whitehall Rd. inquired about the status of a permit for his property.

Supervisor DeLello thanked Mr. DePaul for the comment and offered to investigate the matter.

Supervisor Quigley recommended that the response be timely as contractors were probably waiting.

Bob Andorn of Worcester Township spoke regarding documentation for the Township's 2024 Budget. Mr. Andorn questioned the amount of money in the Sewer Fund.

Supervisor DeLello addressed the sewer fund question addressing that the township received ARPA funds for capital improvements. He also addressed the documentation surrounding the budget acknowledging that he had the correct information.

Supervisor Quigley commented regarding the Meadowood Pump Station failure and the insurance claim related to the incident.

1. A motion to approve the consent agenda was made by Supervisor Betz with corrections to the January 17<sup>th</sup> meeting minutes to include comments made concerning an outside financial audit, to address Mr. Andorn's budget concerns. Seconded by Supervisor Quigley. The motion passed unanimously.

## **MOTION**

- a) Mr. Halbom summarized the motion, which requires uniform color coding of Fire Hydrants.

Supervisor Betz made a motion to authorize preparation and advertisement of an amendment to Chapter 41 – Fire Prevention – of the Township Code. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Quigley. Approved unanimously.

- b) Mr. Evarts summarized the work which is taking place on Weber Road. The work requires replacement of a gas line and changes associated with the work.

Supervisor Betz made a motion to authorize payment to DJ Pinciotti Construction Co, Inc. in the amount of \$65,207.70, for the Weber Road Culvert Replacement, Contract number 7200-204A. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Quigley. Approved unanimously.

- c) Mr. Evarts summarized the change order and the reasons for the delay. Mr. Evarts confirmed the Township would seek reimbursement from PECO.

Supervisor Betz made a motion to authorize a change order in the amount of \$29,602.00 to DJ Pinciotti Construction Co, Inc. for bypass pumping items listed on Page 3 of the CKS Memo. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Quigley. Approved unanimously.

## **RESOLUTIONS**

Township Engineer John Evarts gave background on the grant which would provide for 1,100 linear feet of stream bank restoration. A motion was made by Supervisor Betz to approve Resolution 2024-06: A Resolution concerning application for grant revenue from the Montgomery County 2040 Grant in the amount of \$350,000. Vice-Chair Betz motioned to approve Resolution 2024-06: concerning application for MontCo 2040 Grant Funds. Supervisor Quigley Seconded the motion. Approved unanimously.

## **PUBLIC HEARINGS**

Conditional Use Application: Variety Club, 2950 Potshop Road – Seeking Athletic Field Lights.

The Board of Supervisors reopened the continued Public Hearing at 7:40PM

The Board of Supervisors resumed the Public Meeting at: 8:55PM

## **OTHER BUSINESS**

Mark Jonas representing Variety Club spoke about the request for a Waiver of Land Development.

Supervisor DeLello expressed concern regarding the availability of parking on site.

Supervisor Betz echoed the concern for parking, specifically safety concerns related to potential roadside parking along Potshop Road. Mr. Evarts was asked by the Board to summarize his review letter.

Mr. Bowker, a representative for Variety summarized the phases of the project and read through the waiver list including:

Partial waiver of land development

Relief for materials of stormwater pipes

Relief for cartway width along Potshop Road

Deferral of sidewalk improvements

Deferral of sidewalk ADA/curbing improvements

Relief for buffer requirements along roadways.

Relief for additional buffer on western side of property where buffer already exists.

Supervisor DeLello Suggested deferment on both the sidewalk and curbing waivers if those were ever to arrive in the area.

John Evarts confirmed CKS believes the buffers are sufficient for the purposes of the ordinance.

Supervisor DeLello confirmed that Variety would be able to comply with the review letter written by the township engineer.

Supervisor Betz made the motion to approve Resolution 2024-07, A Resolution providing a limited waiver of land development to the Variety Club, 2950 Potshop Road, as described by the Township solicitor and subject to the following conditions:

- Compliance with the CKS Engineer Review letter dated February 13, 2024.
- Compliance with the Bowman Traffic Review Letter dated Feb 14, 2024.
- A Development Agreement providing for the posting of financial security attending to the sanitary sewer and stormwater improvements in form satisfactory to the Township solicitor and Township Engineer shall be executed before recording the plan.
- There shall be No Parking along road frontage. The Township shall retain the ability to require the applicant take steps to remediate parking problems identified by the Township. Remediation steps may include – by way of example – requirements to install additional parking facilities, restrictions on the number of games at the facility hosted per day or staggering of game schedules.
- A waiver from section 130-16(b)a1-6 (minimum cartway width)
- A deferral from sidewalk installation until required by Township.
- A deferral from 130-18(b) (curbing), until required by Township.
- A waiver 130-128G(5), to not provide a softening buffer

- A waiver of 130-128G(5), where an existing buffer already exists.
- A waiver of 129-18 (2)(3), to allow for HDPE in place of Concrete pipes.

The motion was seconded by Supervisor Quigley. It passed unanimously.

### **BOARD COMMENT**

Supervisor Betz revisited the issue of budget documents.

### **PUBLIC COMMENT**

There was no public comment.

### **ADJOURNMENT**

**CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor DeLello at 6:30 PM.

Supervisor Quigley was absent at the start of the meeting.

**Announcements**

The Township Manager announced the meeting would be recorder for future broadcast, and that the Board of Supervisors met in executive session on:

- 1/24/2023 to discuss litigation.
- 2/1/2024 to discuss personnel.
- 2/19/2024 to discuss personnel, litigation, and real estate.

**Public Comment**

Carrol Otten 1640 Krebel Mill Road. Commented about a neighboring property landscaping their property absent permits. She cited several issues and concerns related to the work.

Supervisor DeLello responded that the Board would investigate the matter.

**Old Duchie Church**

The Township manager provided some background about the Old Dutchie Church property following the Township's acquisition of the property. He shared the renovations necessary would likely require a public bid process to identify contractors. He reported necessary renovations included new windows, doors, and shutters. The work would have to comply with historic standards to be eligible for certain grant revenue.

Jim Thompson, President of the Worcester Township Historical Society provided an update from the Historical Society. Jim called attention to the two existing buildings on the Historic Register in Worcester, Peter Wentz Farm and the Anthony Morris Building. He offered there was value in registering the Old Dutchie Church. Jim echoed the difficulties identifying qualified carpenters to perform historic work.

Mr. Thompson gave information about the history of the buildings, and he also described the difficulty the Historical Society had holding events at the church, specifically due to parking constraints.

Supervisor DeLello discussed the possibility of connecting the trail system to alleviate parking concerns. He also questioned the requirements to be on the National Register of Historic Places.

Mr. Thompson described some renovation work done in 2006. The Board discussed some past renovations and past events held at the Church. The Board discussed the potential uses of the site with Jim Thompson and reviewed photos and aerials of the site and surrounding area.

The Board agreed to further the discussion and the property's role in the larger portfolio of Township properties. The Board directed staff to continue seeking out options for the identification of contractors and steps involved in bidding the work.

#### **Public Comment**

Christopher DePaul 1660 Whitehall: Chris drew the Board's attention to a list of vendors with the Philadelphia Historical Society.

The session was adjourned at 7:00 PM

**SUBJECT:** Engineering Report - Project Status

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This memorandum will provide an update and status report on the various projects that are ongoing within the Township as of January 10, 2024.

1. **Turnpike Sound Barriers Grant Project (No Change):** The pre-construction meeting for the project was held on February 1, 2022. The Notice to Proceed was issued and the project is scheduled for September 2022 completion. All submittals have now been approved and the panels and steel posts are in production. Construction has started. All occasions are installed, and the panel installation is now complete. Final site restoration is underway. Project is now complete. Final Grant submission due June 30, 2023. Documentation was provided to The Commonwealth Financing Authority on July 6, 2023 for reimbursement.
2. **Valley Green WWTP Filter Project (No Change):** The contracts for the Tertiary Filter Project have been awarded. The new filter has been ordered and is ready for delivery. We continue with reviewing submittals for the project. Construction on the building and the filter installation is nearing completion. Filter is now in operation and working well. Electrical contractors need to complete work. Electrical panel has been received and work is anticipated to be completed in September. Final inspection complete and contractor has a small punch list to complete. Project is complete and 12-Month Maintenance Period has begun.
3. **Evansburg Park Trail:** The revised trail location has been approved. CKS has completed the additional field survey work due to the changes. We are proceeding with the plan preparation, and we are coordinating this project with the Township, and the Township's traffic engineer. We are working on the trail design and the pedestrian bridge. McMahon will design the Kratz Road Crossing. We are coordinating the final trail location within the park. Coordination with PennDOT and Evansburg Park on the road crossing. Meeting with MCCD held on June 12, 2023. Trail design continues along with coordination with outside agencies and Township Traffic engineer. CKS Engineers completed additional survey work on December 7, 2023. Ongoing coordination with PECO to determine the best pedestrian crossing locations.
4. **Storage Building at Compost Facility (No Change):** Bids will be opened on April 5, 2023 for a storage building at the Compost Facility at Nice Park. We will review and provide a recommendation to the Township. Contract is awarded. Township has



prepared site. Notice to Proceed has been issued. Contractor to deliver building materials to the site in the near future. Public works to observe construction of the building. CKS Engineers has reviewed and approved the shop drawings. The majority of work on the building has been completed. Last remaining item is for the contractor to install the doors. Work has been completed. Final payment has been requested by the contractor.

5. Weber Road Culvert Replacement: This contract has been awarded, and we are reviewing project submittals. Coordination with PECO and Contractor on going. Culvert was delivered in the second week of July and is currently being stored. A site meeting was held on November 8, 2023 to discuss the relocation of the PECO gas main. Work began on January 2, 2024. PECO to begin their portion of work to relocate gas main the week of January 8, 2024. The Township continues to work with PECO to relocate the gas main which has been more involved than originally planned for. Gas main work is also complete. Culvert is scheduled to be installed the week of March 18, 2024.
6. 2024 Roadway Improvement Project: CKS has prepared specifications and will be released for bidding on March 15, 2024 and opened on April 10, 2024
7. Miscellaneous Items
  - a. CKS Engineers assisted the Township on numerous zoning and land development related issues as requested during the month.
  - b. CKS Engineers performed various site inspections in conjunction with finalizing Use & Occupancy Permits during the month.
  - c. CKS Engineers reviewed numerous grading permit applications and storm-water applications for the Township during the month.
  - d. CKS Engineers continued to provide inspection services in conjunction with all ongoing land development and subdivision projects throughout the Township. This also included verifying completion of items and preparation of escrow releases for these projects, as requested.
  - e. CKS Engineers continues to assist in work required in conjunction with the review and approval of subdivisions and land developments and Conditional Use applications submitted to the Township. These currently include the Palmer Tract, Huginar property (under construction), the Dubner property (under review), Zacharczuk property (aka Bell Flower, under construction) and North Grange LLC, (Waiver of Land Development) and the Variety Club proposed Athletic Fields (Conditional Use and Potential Waiver of Land Development). There is also a project in the sketch plan phase for the property at 1570 Whitehall Road. A minor subdivision plan (Kerper Property) has also been reviewed and has been approved. There is a project in the sketch plan phase for the property at 1035 Troop Road (aka O'Donnell Property).

The above represents a status report on the projects and services currently being performed by CKS Engineers. Please contact me if you have any questions on any of these items.

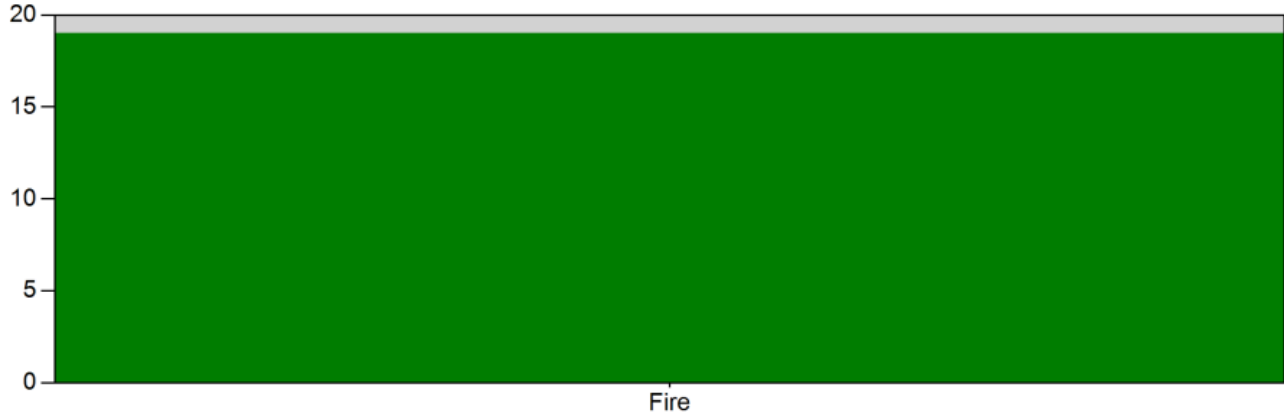

Found blower belts for #3 train blower broken, shut down blower and replaced belts.

**Berwick Place WWTP**

1/02/24 - EXTRA TIME 1 HOUR

Found #3, #4 train blower belts broken. Shut down blower and replaced belts.

1/10/24 - WEDNESDAY BERWICK PLACE EXTRA TIME 10:00AM TO 7:00PM

Heavy rain event, increased flow through plant to help lower levels in both sides pre-eq tanks. Franc on site to pull 3 loads from SHT's. Wasted as needed to keep blanket in clarifiers down. Turned air off in last aeration tanks to help keep blankets down. Pump from one side pre-eq tank to the other as levels dropped to try and keep up with influent. Fight I and I all day.

1/20/24 - Worcester Township-Emergency call out @ 1400 hours for a possible sewer main leak at the intersection of Valley Forge Road and Road. Arrived on the scene and found a small hole about 7" in diameter with evidence of leaking sewage. This forced main is a 2" discharge from Fawn Creek PS into the gravity manhole VG2. Opened both the manhole with the pressure relief valve near the leak and the discharge further down closer to the Valley Green WWTP. Both were clean and no signs of leaks. Called Pascerini Contractors to open an emergency PA One call and to get a crew to dig the street. Once the area was excavated the faulty part was a Schedule 80 ball valve that was left closed possibly as another air relief that had frozen and split in half. Once exposed the pumps were shut down at Fawn Creek PS and a repair cap was glued into place. After it had dried the PS was put back online with the pump on to test for any leaks for which there were none found. The excavation was filled back in with gravel from the township lot and the black top was filled with cold patch. Emergency crew completed the work, and the system was restored to normal @ 2300 hours. Total time 9 hours.

**ORDINANCE 2024-297**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 41 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE**

**WHEREAS**, from time to time, additions and other revisions are required to be made to Township Code of Worcester Township; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Township desires to make additions to Chapter 41, Fire Prevention, of the Township Code;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Board of Supervisors of Worcester Township, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania hereby ordains and enacts as follows:

**SECTION I**

1. Chapter 41, Fire Prevention, §41-5 shall be added, and shall read as follows:

Fire Hydrant Specifications and Color-Coding Standards:

- A. All fire hydrants shall have national standard threads and be approved by the Fire Marshal.
- B. All fire hydrants shall comply with the color-coding requirements established by the Fire Marshal, as follows:
  - 1) Fire hydrants connected to water supplies shall be painted red or white with the bonnet (top portion) color coded to identify the diameter of the water main feeding the hydrant as follows:
    - i) Bonnets shall be painted red for fire hydrants connected to water mains 4-inches in diameter.
    - ii) Bonnets shall be painted orange for fire hydrants connected to water mains 6-inches in diameter.
    - iii) Bonnets shall be painted yellow for fire hydrants connected to water mains 8-inches in diameter.
    - iv) Bonnets shall be painted green for fire hydrants connected to water mains 12-inches in diameter.
    - v) Bonnets shall be painted blue for fire hydrants connected to water mains 16-inches in diameter.
    - vi) Hydrant barrels shall be painted red or white unless otherwise approved by the Township Fire Marshal.

**SECTION II**

1. In the event that any section, subsection or portion of this Ordinance shall be declared by any competent court to be invalid for any reason, such decision shall not be deemed to affect the validity of any other section, subsection or portion of this Ordinance. The invalidity of section, clause, sentence, or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this Ordinance, which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the Township that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such invalid section, clause, sentence, or provision not been included therein.
2. To the extent this Ordinance is inconsistent with the Code of Worcester Township, the provisions of this Ordinance shall take precedence. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
3. The failure of the Township to enforce any provision of this ordinance shall not constitute a waiver by the Township of its rights of future enforcement hereunder.
4. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment.
